## Dear parent(s) and/or guardian(s),

I trust this letter finds you well and I hope that you have been able to read our previous letter dated March 12, 2020. As stated in that letter, I would inform you once schools will be closed, which will be as of tomorrow March 19, 2020.

- All students have been registered on the ClassDojo learning platform (<a href="https://www.classdojo.com/">https://www.classdojo.com/</a>) and they have been taught how to log on and use the platform (CCSLC / PRO / CSEC / CVQ / MBO).
- CAPE students are already in contact with their teachers as part of their blended learning program and are not requested to sign up for ClassDojo.
- All teachers will upload the assigned work for the classes on ClassDojo so that the students can see what is expected of them. The work does not just entail online assignments, but also assignments such as reading, working on handouts, quizzes etc. What is expected of the students is mentioned in their class-learning environment in ClassDojo.
- Students will be graded on their work.
- In addition to the 'homework', the homeroom teachers will check regularly with their students their well-being and answer any questions / difficulties they might have. The E-schedule will be published on our website and shared via (mass)email.
- In the schedule online-classes will be scheduled. This means, that students are required to login to an online meeting platform called ZOOM. During these classes, teachers will teach and students are able to continue with their learning and assignments with the assistance of the SCS Staff.
- Teachers are always approachable via their SCS e-mail account as mentioned in the School Guide.

- The SBA-onsite moderation has been postponed till further notice.

- The CSEC May/June sittings will be postponed or will continue. More information will follow as soon as we

have more information. The SBA onsite moderation has been postponed till further notice.

By means of this letter I once more would like to request your support and supervision with the execution of the
