## Start-up allowance

 To cover your first costs between the BES-islands and the Netherlands pending the DUO Study Financing

(Vocational level 1 and 2 NO!)



## Caribbean

US Virgin Islands, Anguilla, Antiqua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Bermuda, British Virgin Islands , Colombia, Costa Rica , Cuba, Dominica , Dominican Republic, Grenada, Guadeloupe, Haiti, Jamaica, Cayman Islands, Montserrat, Puorto Rico, Saint Barthélemy, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands and Venezuela.

## Conditions to be eligible for financing

- Must be registered at the Census Office on Bonaire, Saba or St. Eustatius
- Should start studying before reaching the age of 30 years
- Should have a certificate of registration from the school you are going to attent
- Must be a resident of the island longer than 10 years or have the Dutch nationality

 Before the start of an academic year or during that academic year

## To apply for study financing







#### Apply for study financing

You can apply for a study financing using the form <u>Application for a student</u> grant for the <u>Dutch Caribbean</u> (pdf).

With the same form, you can also change your application for a study financing.



## To apply for a start-up allowance



#### Apply for a start-up allowance

You can apply for the start-up allowance for a course in vocational education level 3 or 4 and higher education in the European part of the Netherlands. The start-up allowance does not apply to vocational education level 1 or 2.

The start-up allowance consists of a performance-related grant and a loan. The performance-related grant is converted into a gift if you obtain a diploma within ten years. You must always repay the part of the start-up allowance that you borrow.

You can apply for the start-up allowance with the form <u>Application for start-up allowance for the Dutch Caribbean</u> (pdf, in Dutch). You can also use this form if you want to amend your application.

## Performance grant or gift

 When you complete your study and receive a diploma, the performance grant will become a gift otherwise it will be a *loan*

### <u>Loan</u>

- You should always repay
- Interest 2021 = 0.00%
- Interest starts from the moment of your first payment!!!

## Studying in the Netherlands

- Apply directly to DUO
- Dutch nationality
- Older than 18 years (Vocational study)
- Enrolled in a school
  - Vocational: application form/on-line
  - Higher education: <a href="https://www.studielink.nl">www.studielink.nl</a> (before May 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Parents must fill out tax forms every year

## Younger than 18 years

- Contact the Court of Guardian
- Higher education will be eligible for DUO-Study Financing from October of the academic year
- Vocational education will not be eligible for DUO- Study Financing
